2010 LedgePark Swim Team Registration Info

How to Register:

There are two options for registration this year:

1. **Register by mail.** Complete all four(4) Forms~ the **Parent/Volunteer Commitment Form**, the **SSL Consent and Release Form**, the **LedgePark Registration Form**, and the **Swim Suit Order Form** and send it along with your payment to: Karen Andersen, 12226 Windcliff Road, Strongsville OH 44136
2. **Register in person** on **Sunday, March 28, 2010**, at the Ledgewood Clubhouse from **1:00pm-4:00pm**. Swim suit samples will be available to try on and order.

Additional information regarding apparel, swim meet schedules and parent job assignments will be available on registration day. Fees and details are listed below. Payment is due by no later than May 1st. Registration is not complete until full payment is received. **If you have specific questions, contact Karen Andersen at 440-238-3781.**

Who is eligible to participate on the team?

All children of Ledgewood residents, up to the age of 18, are eligible to participate.

**Non-resident grandchildren of Ledgewood residents can participate on the team, but they must go through the appropriate approval process in accordance with the Strongsville Swim League By-Laws (SSL)*

How much does it cost?

The cost is \$100 for the 1st child, \$75 for the 2nd child and \$50 for each additional child per family. Swimmers are also responsible for purchasing a team swim suit. Each paid registered swimmer will receive a **FREE LedgePark Pirates T-Shirt and FREE swim duffle bag.**

**Families must be current with their Ledgewood Association fees to participate on the swim team.*

Does my child need to be a strong swimmer to be on the team?

No, but in order to compete in a swim meet, they must be able to swim on their own across the width of the pool. (Doggie Paddle is fine!) If your child needs one-on-one attention in order to stay afloat, it would be a good idea to enroll them in **Learn-To-Swim** first.

Do parents have to participate in swim team activities?

Yes! All parents/families are required to help throughout the swim season. Job assignments are given at the start of the season. Assignments include a variety of jobs during a swim meet, such as being a timer, working the concession stand or helping with ribbons. If working at the meet is difficult for parents, there are a number of other activities you can help with, such as planning an outing or helping with a fund raising event. **Parent meeting** will be held at **1:00 Sunday March 28th** at Clubhouse during registration to help answer any questions and get feedback from our valued parents and volunteers.

When is the swim season?

The seven week season begins June 1st with practices and wraps up at the Championship weekend with CHAMPS Meet on Saturday, July 17 and Banquet held July 18th, 2010.

When are the practices?

After school practices begin following the Memorial Day weekend. M-F 4:30-5:30 June 1– June 9th. Morning practices begin the first weekday after Strongsville schools are out for the summer. Monday-Friday June 10– July 16. Children ages 9 and older practice from 9:00 am—10:30 am; Ages 8 and under practice from 10:00am—11:00am.
